

MYTHS

Some of these myths have been floating around and are NOT TRUE:

- "The board has already made a decision that Spalding Drive is closing" - although a recommendation has been made, a final decision will not be made until early 2025
- "Ison Springs is already at capacity" Ison Springs has an enrollment of under 450 students and a capacity of 800 students; it was built in 2009

THINGS TO AVOID

- Do NOT organize at the school or use school facilities
- Do NOT place flyers inside mailboxes, but flyers can be taped to mailboxes or hung from them
- We CANNOT use the electric sign in front of the school
- Do NOT ask for endorsements from Spalding faculty or staff
- Do NOT include endorsements from any staff in communications to the board or teachers
